



Mission Update on Momentum Vigoride 7 Orbital Service Vehicle

March 31, 2026

Launched on March 30 on SpaceX Transporter-16 Mission Carrying 10 Payloads

SAN JOSE, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Mar. 31, 2026-- **Momentum Inc. (NASDAQ: MNTS) (“Momentum” or the “Company”)**, a U.S. commercial space company specializing in satellite technology, space transportation, and in-orbit services, today announced the successful deployment and early commissioning of its Vigoride 7 Orbital Service Vehicle following launch aboard SpaceX’s Transporter -16 mission.

Vigoride 7 represents a significant operational milestone for the Company as it begins a series of in space operations designed to test, validate and showcase a suite of next-generation capabilities. Over the coming months, the spacecraft is expected to host and operate 10 government and commercial payloads, including demonstrations of autonomous rendezvous and proximity operations (RPO), in-space assembly technologies, and advanced satellite servicing functions — all key growth areas in the emerging orbital economy.

Following separation from the SpaceX Falcon-9 Launch Vehicle as part of the Transporter-16 rideshare mission, at approximately 500 km altitude, Vigoride 7’s 1.6-kilowatt solar arrays were successfully deployed and are providing power to the vehicle. Communications with Vigoride 7 have been successfully executed, including command uplink and telemetry downlink. All systems are stable and the vehicle will be monitored closely as commissioning commences for all the bus subsystems in preparation for supporting each of the 10 hosted payloads aboard Vigoride 7 over the next several months.

This mission marks Momentum’s fourth Vigoride deployment, reinforcing the Company’s track record of consistent execution. Momentum’s follow-on Vigoride 8 mission, planned to launch in 2027, is already fully allocated to a U.S. government customer.

Momentum CEO John Rood commented: “We’re very happy about the momentum at the company right now. It’s great to have launched another spacecraft, to have our next mission sold out for a government customer, and to operate from the strongest financial position we’ve been in for some time. We’re excited for the future.”

Through its Vigoride orbital service vehicle, the company delivers hosted payload support, last-mile delivery, and servicing capabilities tailored to scalable mission architectures.
