This prospectus supplement supplements the prospectus dated September 15, 2021 (the “Prospectus”), which forms a part of our registration statement on Form S-1 (No. 333-259281). This prospectus supplement is being filed to update the prospectus with the information contained in our current report on Form 8-K, filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) on August 2, 2022 (the “Current Report”). The text of Item 7.01 of our Current Report on Form 8-K and those exhibits filed as part of the Current Report are attached to and a part of this prospectus supplement.

The Prospectus and this prospectus supplement relate to the offer and sale from time to time by the selling securityholders named in the Prospectus (the “Selling Securityholders”) of up to (A) 54,579,637 shares of our Class A common stock, par value \$0.00001 per share (“Class A Stock”), which consists of (i) 495,000 shares of Class A Stock (the “Founder Shares”) originally issued in a private placement to SRC-NI Holdings, LLC (the “Sponsor”) in connection with the initial public offering (the “IPO”) of Stable Road Acquisition Corp. (“SRAC”) and subsequently distributed to certain equityholders of the Sponsor, (ii) 50,000 shares of Class A Stock (the “Underwriter Shares”) originally issued in a private placement to and Cantor Fitzgerald & Co. (“Cantor”) in connection with the IPO, (iii) 50,000 shares of Class A Stock (the “Finder Shares”) issued pursuant to a finder’s agreement dated June 28, 2020, (iv) 4,062,500 shares of Class A Stock originally issued to the Sponsor and SRAC PIPE Partners LLC in connection with the IPO, (v) 25,996,648 shares of Class A Stock issued pursuant to the Merger Agreement (as defined in the Prospectus), (vi) 11,000,000 shares of Common Stock issued to certain investors pursuant to subscription agreements dated July 15, 2021 (the “PIPE Shares”), (vii) 11,272,500 shares of Class A Stock issuable upon the exercise of 11,272,500 warrants originally issued in a private placement to the Sponsor and Cantor in connection with the IPO (the “Sponsor and Underwriter Private Warrants”) or in a private placement in connection with the Business Combination (as defined in the Prospectus) (the “PIPE Private Warrants”), in each case at an exercise price of \$11.50 per share of Class A Stock (collectively, the “Private Warrants”), (viii) up to 1,018,281 shares of Class A Stock issuable upon the exercise of certain Rollover Options (as defined in the Prospectus), and (ix) 634,708 shares of Class A Stock issued upon the exercise of certain Rollover Options and (B) up to 272,500 Private Warrants.

In addition, the Prospectus relates to the offer and sale of up to 8,625,000 shares of Class A Stock that are issuable by us upon the exercise of 8,625,000 warrants originally issued in connection with the IPO at an exercise price of \$11.50 per share of Class A Stock (the “Public Warrants” and, together with the Private Warrants, the “Warrants”).

Our Class A Stock and Public Warrants are listed on the Nasdaq Global Select Market under the symbols “MNTS” and “MNTSW,” respectively. On May 6, 2022, the last reported sales price of our Class A Stock was \$2.95 per share and the last reported sales price of our Public Warrants was \$0.52 per warrant.

This prospectus supplement should be read in conjunction with the Prospectus, and this prospectus supplement is qualified by reference to the Prospectus, except to the extent that the information provided by this prospectus supplement supersedes the information contained in the Prospectus.

This prospectus supplement is not complete without, and may not be delivered or utilized except in connection with, the Prospectus dated September 15, 2021 with respect to the securities described above, including any amendments or supplements thereto.

We are an “emerging growth company” as defined in Section 2(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and, as such, have elected to comply with certain reduced disclosure and regulatory requirements.

Momentum First Demonstration Mission Status Update #4

SAN JOSE, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE) – August 2, 2022 – Momentum Inc. (NASDAQ: MNTS) ("Momentum" or the "Company"), a U.S. commercial space company that plans to offer transportation and other in-space infrastructure services, today provided its fourth Mission Update on its inaugural Vigoride mission that launched on May 25

Since the Company's last update on June 29, Momentum has successfully deployed four additional customer satellites.

Momentum initially deployed two customer satellites from its Vigoride-3 Orbital Transfer Vehicle on May 28. The most recent deployments of four additional customer satellites occurred in July.

The Company also deployed one customer satellite on May 25 from a third-party deployer that flew on a second port of the launch vehicle. A total of seven Momentum customer satellites have now been deployed in low Earth orbit, and three yet-to-be-deployed satellites remain on Vigoride.

As stated in past updates on the initial Vigoride mission, after experiencing anomalies on the spacecraft, the Company has continued efforts to deploy additional customer satellites. The Company continues to monitor the Vigoride-3 vehicle's status and will continue efforts to deploy the remaining three customer satellites onboard.

Momentum's plans for additional launches of the Vigoride vehicle later this year and in 2023 remain as stated in the Q1 earnings call on May 10, 2022, with agreements signed with SpaceX for launches on upcoming Transporter missions in 2022 and 2023, including Transporter-6 currently targeted for November 2022.

The Company has identified the root cause of the anomalies experienced during the initial Vigoride demonstration mission. Momentum convened an Independent Review Team of highly experienced space experts who reviewed the root cause findings of our engineers and concurred with their findings. Momentum has made good progress in implementing corrective actions on the Vigoride-5 vehicle that the Company plans to fly on the SpaceX Transporter-6 mission.

"We have completed our own internal reviews and welcomed an independent review team that conducted a comprehensive assessment of our first mission," said Momentum Chief Executive Officer John Rood. "We learned a lot from our first Vigoride demonstration mission already and intend to learn everything we can before the mission is over. Albert Einstein famously remarked, 'The only source of knowledge is experience,' and we are intently focused on implementing the knowledge and lessons learned from the experience of our first demonstration mission on our second Vigoride demonstration flight this fall."

Momentus is a U.S. commercial space company that plans to offer in-space infrastructure services, including in-space transportation, hosted payloads and in-orbit services. Momentus believes it can make new ways of operating in space possible with its planned in-space transfer and service vehicles that will be powered by an innovative water plasma-based propulsion system that is under development.
